The Big Apple Welcomes Back Odyssey of the Seas, and Brilliance of the Seas Returns to Boston

MIAMI, Feb. 14, 2024 – New island-hopping vacations are around every corner: Royal Caribbean International has revealed the next in its lineup of 2025-2026 adventures. For the summer and winter, seven favorites will cruise from seven U.S. cities in Florida, Northeast, Puerto Rico and Texas on 5- to 12-night vacations.
